**PURPOSE**

To define the process to follow that will acknowledge the resident's preferences should they be contrary to medical advice and/or raise safety concerns.

To accommodate the resident's preference within the safety, legal and regulatory requirements that apply to Prairie North Regional Health Authority (PNRHA) long term care facilities.

**POLICY STATEMENT**

All PNRHA long term care facilities will utilize a Managed Risk Negotiated Agreement which is a written agreement between the care provider and resident and/or resident/PNRHA legal representatives that detail the parties discussions and agreements regarding the resident's preferences and the manner that they will be accommodated in the long term care facility.

It describes the process by which the resident and/or resident's legal representative knowingly decides to accept a risk after being informed about the risk.
